Our pupils are drawn from Crawley, Horsham, East Sussex and Surrey and there are over 1000 pupils in the school. In the secondary phase, we are four form entry throughout Years 7 to 11, whilst our Primary phase is 2 form entry from Reception to Year 6.

Aurora was established as a multi-academy trust in September 2012. There are currently seven schools in the trust, over 400 employees and our schools cater for around 3000 pupils.
